The line breaks denote the pattern of clustering among the schools. Some 150 points separate HEC School of Management at the top, from the school ranked number 55. The top ten business schools, from HEC to Insead, form the top group of schools. The second group is headed by Esade Business School, which would need to increase its score by eight per cent overall in order to enter the top group. The third group is headed by the Copenhagen Business School and the fourth by the Rouen School of Management.
